

RESOLUTION #19-72

ANNEX SAFE WATER EXPENDITURE

WHEREAS the Bremer County Annex is located in a building separate from that of the court house at 203 1st Ave. NE, Waverly, Iowa. That the source of water for visitors and employees to drink is a sink faucet in a public restroom. That the Veterans Affairs, Mental Health, Substance Abuse, and General Assistance Departments have an interest in providing a safe source of drinking water for visitors and office employees. That the health, safety, and morale of visitors and public employees is a recognized public expense. That the Veterans Affairs, Mental Health, Substance Abuse and General Assistance office provides such safe water through a common business expense commonly referred to as a “cooler.” That the cooler consists of jugs of water through a water dispenser.

WHEREAS the State Auditor’s office has requested that a Resolution recognize the expense. That the Bremer County Board of Supervisors has approved the expenditure for water in the Bremer County Annex since 2019 as a recognized public expense. That such expense is reasonable.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Bremer County Board of Supervisors to authorize the use of funds to provide a healthy and safe source of dispensed drinking water for the Bremer County Annex.
